Psalm 91



Psalm 91 is a very powerful psalm that holds many promises from God. It is an assurance of protection, comfort, of strength and power to those who are steadfast in their faith and service of the Lord. It is an assurance of answered prayers, of God's mercy, love, and constant companionship to those who dwell in His fortress.

Psalm 91 Prayer

- ¹He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- ² I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in Him will I trust.
- ³Surely He shall deliver me from the snare of the fowler and from the noisome pestilence.
- ⁴He shall cover me with His feathers, and under His wings shall I trust: his truth shall be my shield and buckler.
- ⁵I shall not be afraid of the terror by night; nor the arrow that flies by day;
- ⁶Nor of the pestilence that stalks in darkness; nor of the destruction and sudden death that lay waste at noonday.
- ⁷A thousand shall fall at my side, and ten thousand at my right hand; but it shall not come near me.
- ⁸Only a spectator shall I be for I am inaccessible in the secret place of the Most High as I witness the reward of the wicked.

- ⁹Because I have made the Lord my refuge, and the Most High my dwelling place,
- ¹⁰There shall no evil befall me, nor any plague or calamity come near my tent.
- ¹¹For He will give his angels special charge over me to accompany and defend and preserve me in all my ways of obedience and service.
- ¹²They shall bear me up in their hands, lest I dash my foot against a stone.
- ¹³I shall tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shall I trample underfoot.
- ¹⁴"Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he knows and understands My name, and knows My mercy, love and kindness trusts and relies on Me, knowing I will never forsake him, no, never!
- ¹⁵He shall call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him, and honor him.
- ¹⁶With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation!"
